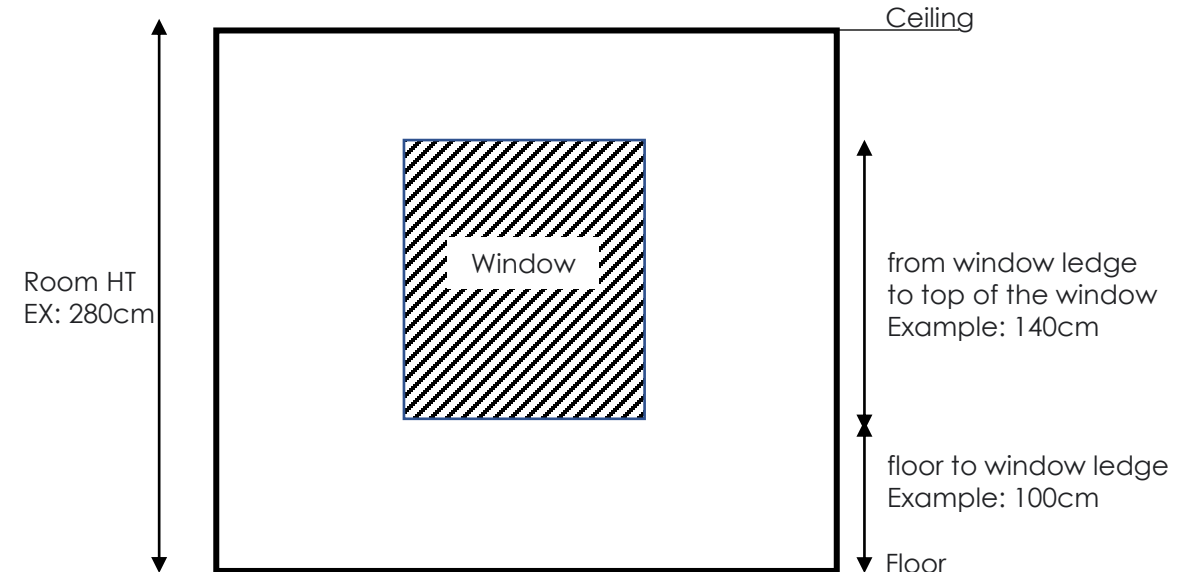
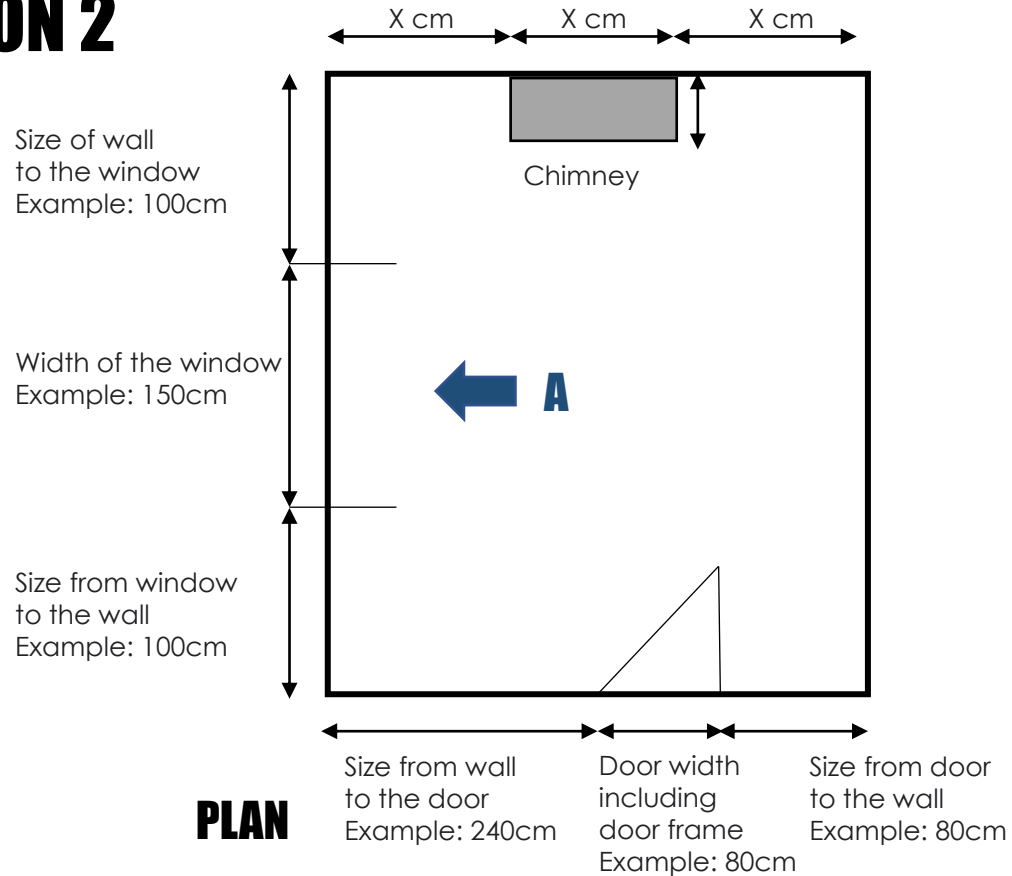
OPTION 1

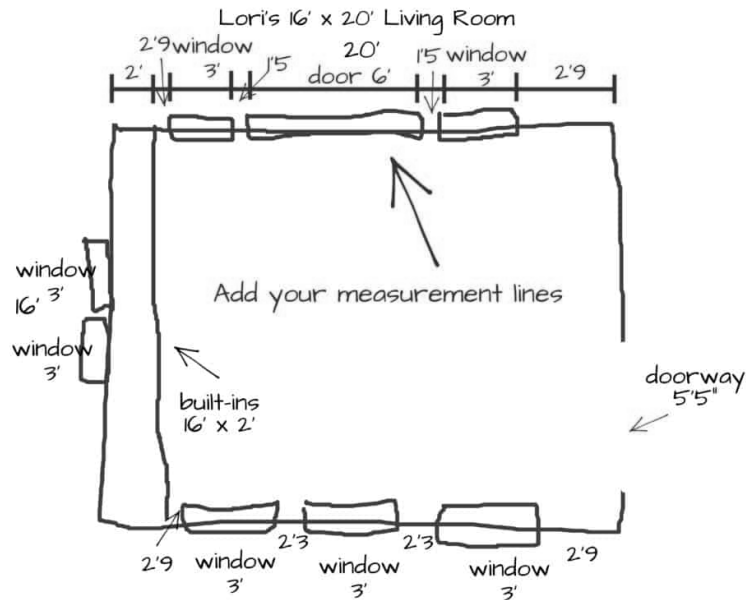
OPTION 2



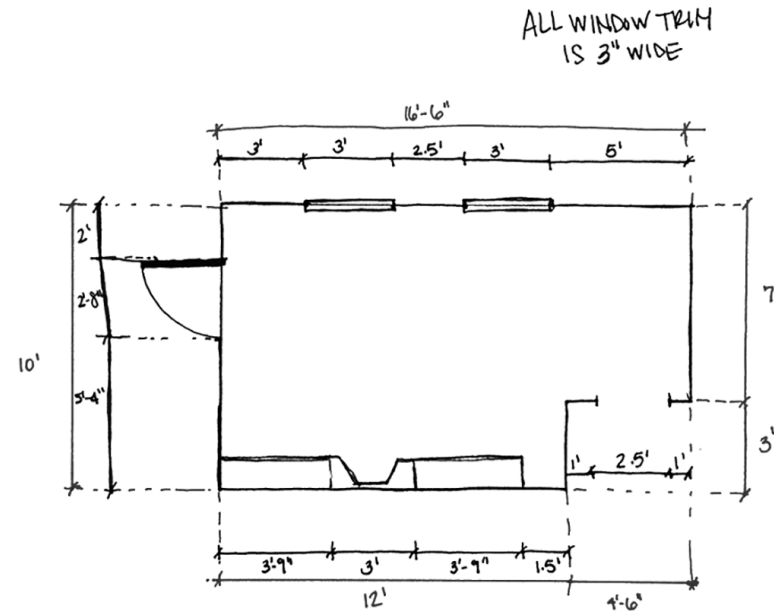
- Your sketch doesn't have to be to scale
